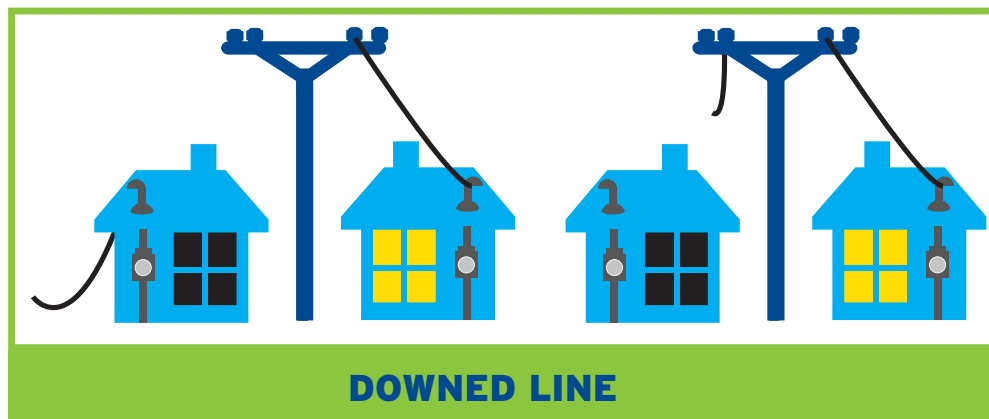


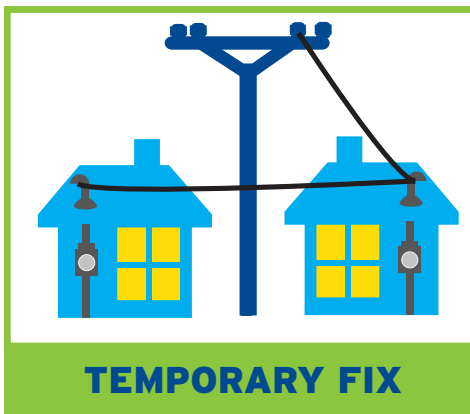
HOUSE-TO-HOUSE TEMPORARY RESTORATION

In an effort to restore power to all of our customers more quickly, we are implementing a temporary fix for situations where a wire to a home has been disconnected either from the main pole or from the house itself.



Our crews will safely cut and remove as much of the wire as possible. You may notice a portion of the wire still connected to the pole. Our crews will secure the wire to make it safe.

Once our work is complete, instead of the wire being connected to the main pole, it may now be connected to your neighbor's house. Don't worry, you are not being charged for the power your neighbor uses.



Even though a DTE crew has worked to temporarily restore your power, as always, you should still consider any wire as energized.

Make sure to stay at least 20 ft away from all power lines and anything they may come in contact with.

Once all customers impacted by Wednesday's storm have been restored, our crews will come back and permanently repair the line.
