**1.41** tons of waste recycled by park visitors and Lumen Detroit guests



**41** trees on site capturing 1,500 pounds of CO<sub>2</sub> annually



**4** electric vehicle charging stations nearby



**4** bioswales help filter pollutants and reduce stormwater runoff

Bio-diverse habitat and native species onsite act as a bee sanctuary location



Lumen Detroit was established and built as a Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design (LEED) Silver Certified building.

## Accessibility & Connectivity

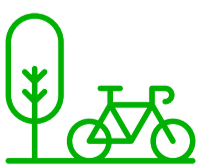
Beacon Park serves as a central destination to help residents and visitors connect with other downtown locations, while helping reduce the local carbon footprint.
