

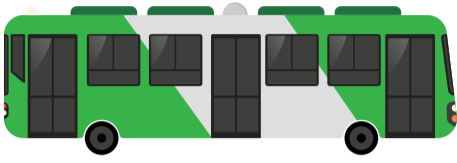

We focus our sustainability efforts in six areas:

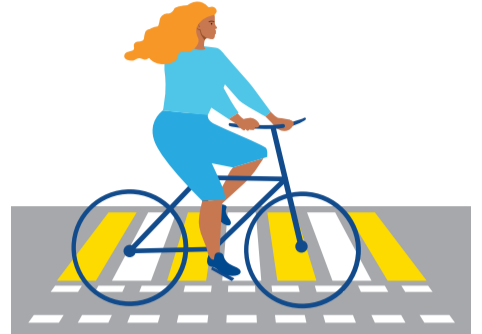
- Environment

Lumen Detroit is a Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design (LEED) **Silver certified** restaurant

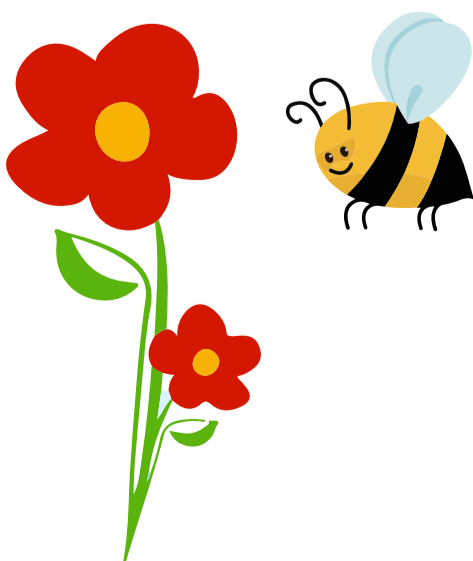
3,400 square foot green roof at **Lumen Detroit** reduces surface runoff by **24%** and can hold up to **3** inches of rainwater
